It was once known as Shore Acres, and Torrey Pines. In the 1990's, the club was purchased a group headed by Jack Bott. Hundreds of trees were brought in, new holes created, and drainage was installed. This new and improved course was named Fenton Farms Golf Club in partial memory of its very first beginnings as a farm. The weather was perfect day for golfing. It was sunny and blue sky.
