Coming up State Tournament this September...



We are celebrating 35 years annual this year. We will play Summit golf course in Shanty Creek Resort in Bellaire, MI. We will stay at the Bellaire Inn, less than 3 mile drive from the course. The hotel rooms at Shanty Creek are already booked, so that's why we're staying in town rather than at the resort. The room plus tax will cost \$76.59 per night. Shanty Creek Resorts in Bellaire just NE of Traverse City is a four season resort that has been ranked Silver Medal Resort by Golf Digest, Top 25 Golf Resort by Travel &

Leisure and Best Golf Resort in Michigan by The Detroit News. Four 18-hole championship layouts include the upscale 4-1/2 star Arnold Palmer designed Legend, the spectacular Tom Wieskopf designed Cedar River, one of Michigan's long time top public courses Schuss Mountain, and the player friendly and original design at Shanty Creek, the Summit. A great variety of dining and recreational opportunities are available. The Summit is the original design at Shanty Creek, and affords golfers an opportunity to play a resort course. Golfers should not expect manicured tees and fairways, but the medium size putting surfaces are mildly undulating, true rolling and kept in very good condition. The terrain is similar to the other three courses, though not as dramatic. Don't miss a great opportunity playing state tournament! Darrell Hovinen was thinking instead of dinner banquet late at Saturday night, we would have a brunch banquet Saturday morning about 9:00am at the Shanty Creek restaurant. Please mark your calendar – September 10th and 11th!
